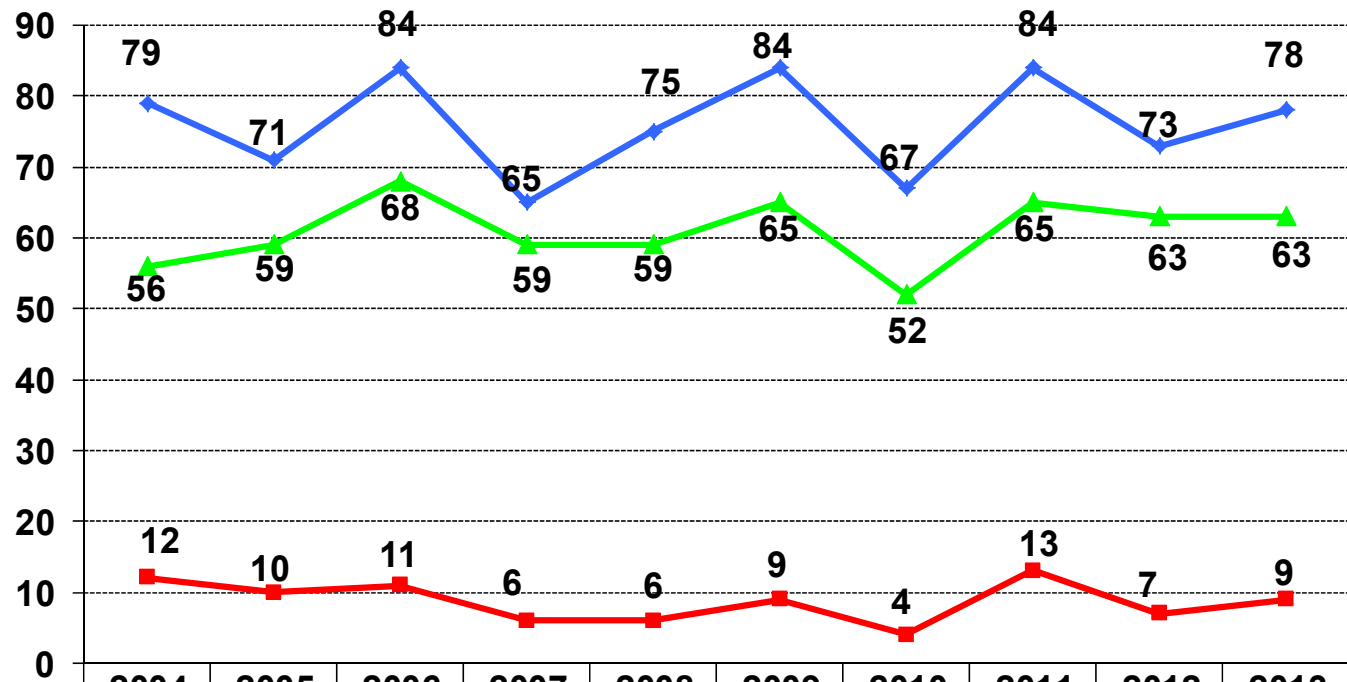

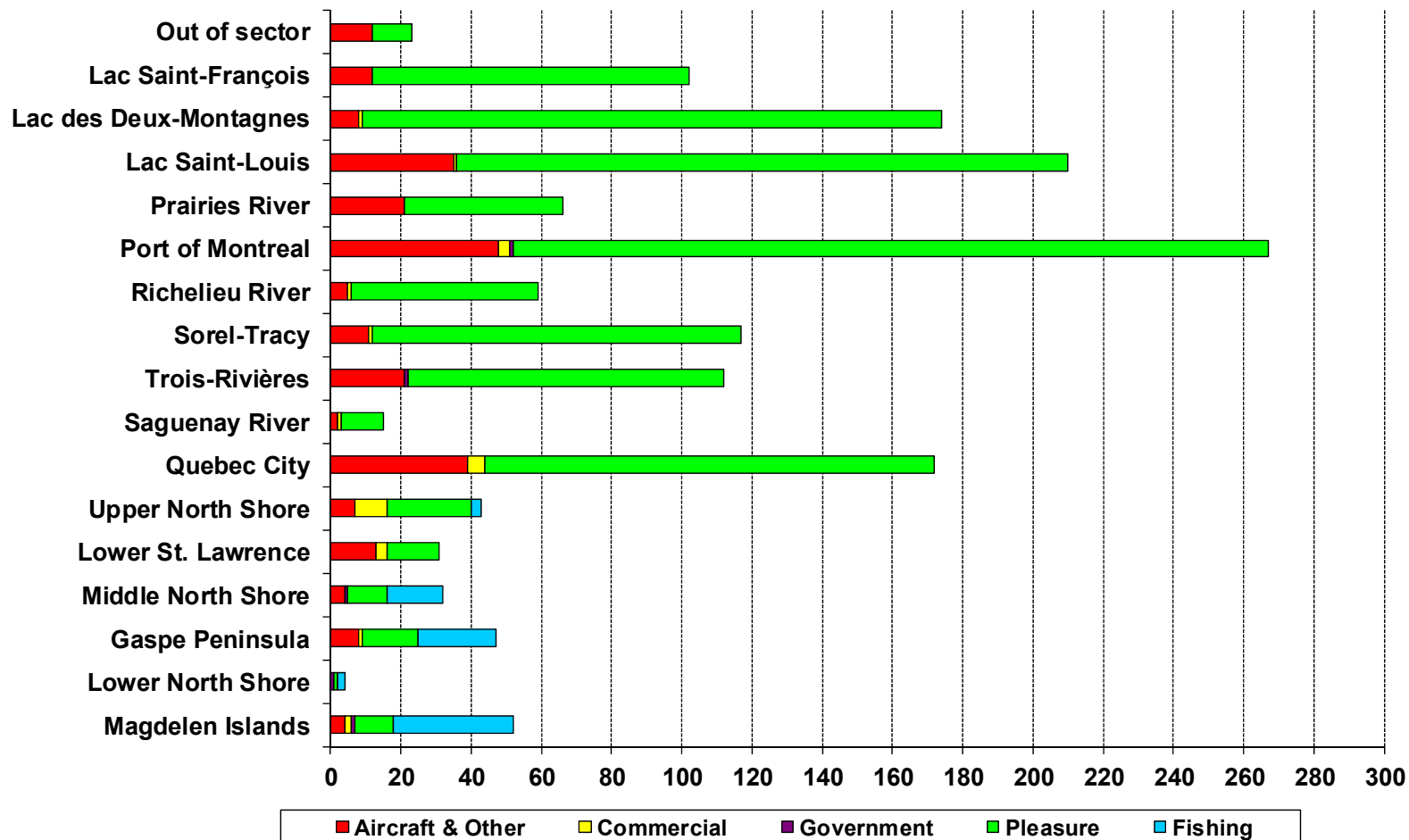

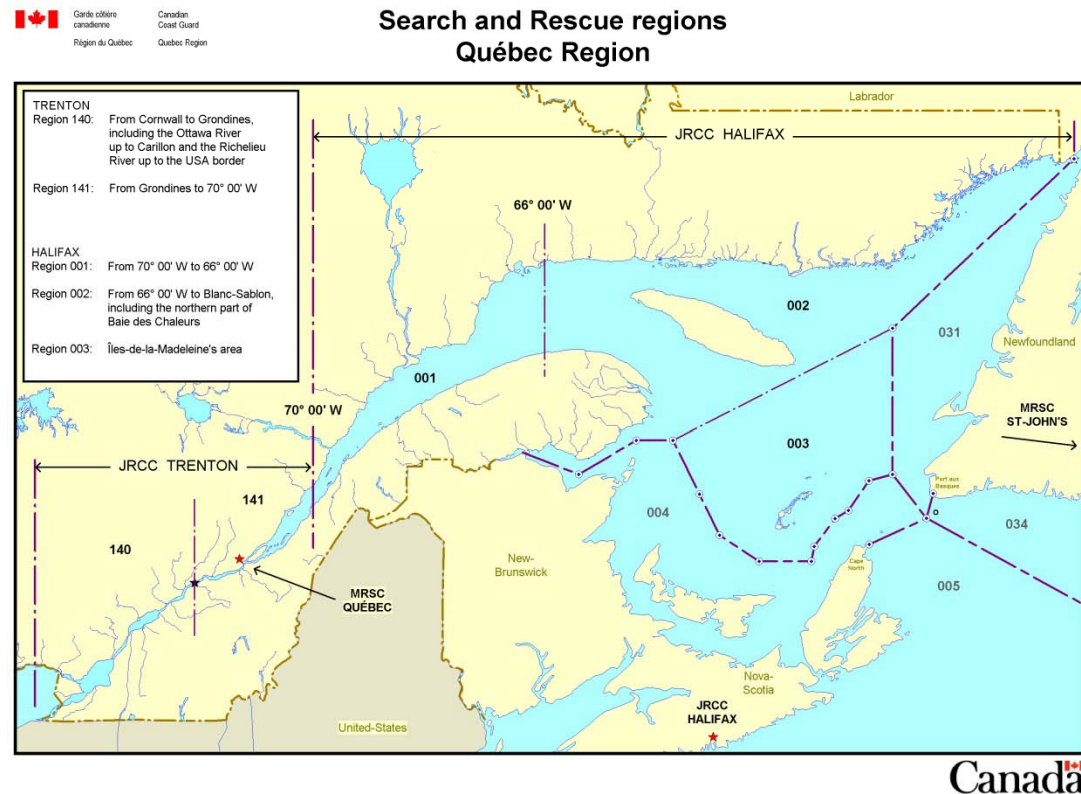
Total crafts assisted by source – 2013



MRSC Quebec territory



In Decembre 2013, the Canadian Coast Guard reversed its decision to close Québec Rescue Center (MRSC Québec), thus maintaining the responsibility of coordination of marine SAR incidents in Québec City.

MRSC Quebec SAR Area

- April 17: F/V JOCELYNE B, south of Port Meunier. Crewmember found unconscious and later deceased despite resuscitation efforts.
- August 13: F/V GAMBLER 5, Havre Aubert Island. Sole operator fell overboard. Recovered by another F/V. Resuscitation efforts engaged with no success.
- October 08: F/V GAI LURON, Rivière-au-Tonnerre. Sole operator on disabled vessel. Two F/V come to assist. Operator fell overboard. The man is later recovered, lifeless, on the beach.

Incident of interest review



F/V SYLVAIN 5

- July 4, 07h00HAE: CAUREQ 911 call, 3 men in an orange liferaft, on the 100 fathoms line, off Cap Gaspé. No other info.
- Request for Mayday Relay broadcast. Tasking of CCGS Cap Rozier, CGA AUX 1268, Parks Canada Forillon 3, DFO Mésis and DND helicopter Cormorant R902.
- In the meantime, F/V Jason B 3 confirms, that he had been in contact with someone requesting assistance. While in the process of lifting his fishing gears, contact was lost.. No other information available.
- Various resources tasked in the vicinity of F/V Jason B 3 and on the 100 fathoms line.

Incident of interest review



- Additional resources tasked, tour boat Narval 3 and DND Hercules R334, while the search area is expended.
- At 10h30EAT, the raft is located by Cormorant R902 and SAR technicians are lowered by winch to the raft, to evaluate survivors state.
- The three survivors are confirmed in good health and safe and are rescued by CCGS Cap Rozier while R902 return to its base with all personal. All resources cancelled.

Constraints encountered:

- Communication with survivors rapidly lost.
- Little if no information on the sunken F/V.
- No EPIRB activation.
- Search area expended rapidly.
