



RATIFICATION BY CANADA

- Canada has ratified the STCW-F Convention in June 2010.
- The STCW-F Convention will come into force on September 29, 2012.







MAIN IMPACTS

In Canada Standards of Training, Certification and Watchkeeping for Fishing Vessels will have to meet STCW-F requirements



Application STCW-F certification requirements

- ➤ Masters and officers in charge of a navigational watch on fishing vessels of **24 metres registered length** and over
- ➤ Engineers and second engineers of fishing vessels of <u>750 kW</u> propulsion power or more (regardless of the length)

MEDICAL CERTIFICATE

A medical certificate <u>will not be required</u> for the purpose of obtaining or renewing the following certificates:

- ✓ Officer, fishing vessels of less than 45 m, Limited waters
- ✓ Fishing Master Fishing vessel of less than 100 GT, Limited water
- ✓ Watchkeeping Mate of a fishing vessel of less than 24 m registered length
- ✓ Certificate of service as Master of a Fishing Vessel of less than 60 GT
- ✓ Certificate of service as Watchkeeping Mate of a fishing vessel of less than 24 m registered length



DECK WATCH REQUIREMENTS (Under section 216 of the MPR)

Navigational Watch shall consist of at least the following:

- **❖** For F/V ≥ 24 meters in registered length:
 - ☐ Remain same concept as stated in MPR under section 216
- ❖ For F/V > 15 GT or > 12 m in overall length and < 24 m in registered length:

A certified master and a certified officer are required on board this size of vessel if the voyage duration requires it.

- a person in charge of the deck watch who in all cases hold the appropriate certificate: or
- a person in charge of the deck watch on stand-by who in all cases hold the appropriate certificate; and

a person standing watch;

and

- Master satisfied that the personnel standing watch is capable of providing proper look-out; and
- The Master shall provide to the personnel standing watch with written instructions that described the master's standing orders which includes « calling the person in charge of the watch ».





DECK WATCH REQUIREMENTS

(Under section 216 of the MPR)

- **❖** For F/V ≤15 GT or ≤ 12 m in overall length:
 - The master who in all cases hold the proper certification and training;
 - ☐ The master on stand-by who in all cases hold the proper certification and training; and
 - a person standing watch

and

- ✓ Master satisfied that the personnel standing watch is capable of providing proper look-out; and
- ✓ The Master shall provide to the personnel standing watch with written instructions that described the master's standing orders which includes « calling the person in charge of the watch ».

(Only a certified master is required on board this size of vessel)

Renewal of Domestic Fishing Vessel Certificates

All certificates valid for 5 years.

New renewal requirements:

Options 1:

Participated in one (1) fishing seasons in the past 12 months;

Option 2:

Participated in two fishing seasons in the past five (5) years; or

Option 3:

Refresher training courses: MED A3 and SVOP.
